YESTERDAY: The Yankees scored 10 runs in bottom of 2nd inning in an 11-2 win over Vermont ... Staten Island got a 3-run homer and 2 3-run doubles in the 10-run inning ... The Lake Monsters scored both of their runs on a **Ricky Nolan** sacrifice fly in the 7th and a **Destin Hood** sac fly in the 8th inning ... Vermont outhit Staten Island 9-6 as the Yankees had just 1 hit besides a 5-hit 2nd inning and 0 hits over the final 4 innings ... **J.J. Sferra** was 3-for-4 for the 2nd straight night, while **Sean Nicol** was 3-for-4 with 1 run ... 7 of the Yankees 10 runs in the 2nd inning were unearned due to error.

FALLING BEHIND: Lake Monsters have been outscored 92-57 by their opponents over the first 2 innings ... **Vermont has been outscored 44-28 in the 1st inning and 48-29 in 2nd.**

HOME VS. AWAY: Vermont went just 14-23 at Centennial Field this season, while the Lake Monsters are 19-18 on road ... **Vermont had just 7 homers at Centennial while allowing 20, while the Lake Monsters have more homers than opponents on road (15-14) ... Lake Monsters were outscored 180-131 by opponents at Centennial, while just 159-157 in road games.**

J.P. BEING J.P.: Outfielder **J.P. Ramirez** has 17 doubles, putting him in 6th-place on the Vermont single-season doubles list ... Ramirez is also tied for 7th in triples for a season with 6, while 4th in at bats (286) and 9th in total bases (117).

LONG BALL: **Sandy Leon's** home run on Friday was the Lake Monsters 1st home run since Vermont hit 3 homers at Brooklyn on August 26th ... **Vermont hit just 7 home runs in 37 games at Centennial Field overall, tying for lowest number ever in a season (Vermont also hit just 7 homers in 2000).**

VS. McNAMARA DIVISION: Vermont is 11-11 vs. the McNamara Division in 2009 ... **Since leaving McNamara Division after the 2001 season, the Lake Monsters have never finished season .500 or better against McNamara teams (11-13 in 2007).**

WHEN GETTING TO FIVE: The Lake Monsters are 20-10 when scoring 5 or more runs in a game, while 13-31 when 4 runs or less ... Vermont is 6-27 when the opponent scores 5 or more, while 27-14 when 4 runs or less ... **Lake Monsters are 21-2 when holding the opponent to 2 runs or less.**
